

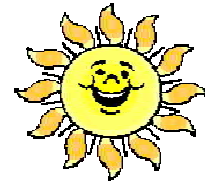

Garbage and Recycling Bins - Please Do Not Place Your Trash Cans In The Street

Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are to be stored out of site from the street. They should be stored in your garage and/or behind your fence. Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are not to be placed out on the curb more than 24 hours prior to our scheduled pickup of Mondays and Thursdays. Tree trimmings, limbs and branches must be cut and bundled into small bundles no longer than 4 feet, and should not weigh over 50 lbs.
