2012 Security Contract

The Board of Directors are requesting MCCIA resident comments regarding the renewal of the contract deputy contract with MCHOA. Currently the contract provides two deputies which is a reduction from 2010 when we had three and reduced the coverage time that the deputies are in our neighborhood in 2011. The number of deputies and coverage could be reduced again in 2012. The cost of the contract did increase in 2010 and again in 2011 even with the reduction of the number of deputies. The cost are expected to increase again in 2012 and the Board of Directors would like residents comments on if they wish to continue to participate in the contract deputy program. With the current state of the economy and residents financial concerns the board is review this annual cost of \$19,680 and all other expenses.

MCCIA Back To School Pool Hours

Effective - Monday August 22, 2011 the pool will be open Saturday and Sundays only - 2pm - 8pm. The pool will also be open on Monday September 5, 2011 for the Labor Day Holiday. The pool will be closed effective September 6, 2011.

MCCIA Common Area Hours

The playground is open during daylight hours only - the park closes at dusk each day. The common area is open to MCCIA residents only. The court area is strictly for basketball or tennis only. No bikes or skating on the courts. The Court area requires a key for admission. If you would like a key to the Court area please go online to complete the required signed form. Each MCCIA must have a key to access the courts - association dues and deed restrictions must be current to be eligible for a court key. A \$25 fee applies for a replacement key.

Burn Ban In Effect

Just as a reminder - MCCIA deed restrictions do not permit burying in the neighborhood. The Harris County Fire Marshalls Office has approved a burn ban for 90 days for Harris County. Annual 2011 Assessments

2011 Annual Assessments are now past due. A \$25 late fee has been charged and interest will be applied to all past due accounts. If you have not paid your 2011 assessments please contact Drew @ Sterling ASI- 832-678-4498 to obtain your current account status. All past due accounts have been submitted for collection.

Garbage and Recycling Bins - Please Do Not Place Your Trash Cans In The Street

Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are to be stored out of sight from the street. They should be stored in your garage and/or behind your fence. Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are not to be placed out on the curb more than 24 hours prior to our scheduled pickup of Mondays and Thursdays. Tree trimmings, limbs and branches must be cut and bundled into small bundles no longer than 4 feet, and should not weigh over 50 lbs. Heavy trash collection is on Thursday and Recycling collection is on Monday. Trash collection holidays and additional information can be found online.

Monthly Reminder

Residents should not store items on their driveways and/or porches. Items should be stored out of site from the front of the home. Trailers are also to be stored out of site from the street.

Deed Restriction Update - Trash Containers / Recycling Bins

Trash containers and recycling bins are to be stored out of view from the front of the home. (Stored behind fences or in garage)

Trash should not be placed at curbside more than 24 hours prior to normal collection.

Trash containers and recycling bins should be picked up from the curbside as soon as possible after collection.
