2008 Budget/Assessment Rate

During the Board meeting on September 13, the draft version of the 2008 budget was presented. Expenses continue to rise each year for the utilities, security fees and insurance premiums to list a few. The board reviewed the budget and approved to leave the 2008 assessment rate at the current rate of \$325.00. The Board will continue to review all expenses to see if there is any way to reduce cost without impacting our community. The Board acknowledged that if cost continued to rise that assessments would have to increase in 2009. The Board will review with residents all options that might be available at the 2008 Annual Homeowners Meeting in February 2008.

Making An Improvement ? - Have you completed an ACC Form ?

If you are planning a project and or any others you need to submit an ACC form in advance. The forms and additional information can be found online. Projects can not begin until your ACC form has been approved. These forms are reviewed at the monthly homeowners meetings. Please make sure you allow time for your ACC form to be processed before you plan to begin your project. ACC forms need to include all required back up which can include color samples, product samples, drawings, lot layout etc. These items are noted on the ACC form. Please include both day and evening contact numbers in case there is a need for additional information.

Garbage and Recycling bins

Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are to be stored out of site from the street. These should be stored in your garage and/or behind your fence. Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are not to be placed out on the curb more than 24 hours prior to our scheduled pickup of Mondays and Thursdays. Tree trimmings, limbs and branches must be cut and bundled into small bundles no longer than 4 feet, and should not weigh over 50 lbs. It's Hurricane season--last month we told you what to when the storm approaches.

This month here's what to do after the storm!

*Remember that you may not have immediate access to your home. Emergency rescue crews, power crews, and other personnel may be attending to special needs. Roads could be blocked, power lines could be down, and people may be trapped and in need of assistance.

*Make sure that you have current identification. You may have to pass through ID check points before being allowed access to your home/neighborhood.

*Avoid driving, as roads may be blocked. Avoid sight-seeing, or entering a storm ravaged area unnecessarily.

*Avoid downed power lines, even if they look harmless. Avoid metal fences and other metal objects near downed lines.

*DO NOT use matches in a storm ravaged area, until all gas lines area checked for leaks. (Keep flashlights and plenty of batteries at hand.)

*Avoid turning the power on at your home if there is flooding present. Have a professional conduct a thorough inspection first.

*Consider having professionals/licensed contractors inspect your home for damage and help in repairs. This includes electricians, as well as professionals to inspect gas lines, remove uprooted trees, and check plumbing. Remember that downed or damaged trees can contain power lines that can be a hazard.

*Use a camera or camcorder to record thoroughly any damage done to your home, before any repairs are attempted.

*In certain areas, the flooding rains that accompany a storm can create pest problems. Be aware of potential pest problems in your area, such as mice , rats, insects or snakes, that may have "come with the storm".
