Trash Collection

Republic Waste - the trash contractor for our area advised that they are back to regular trash collection. This includes picking up all household garbage and 4 bags of weekly yard clippings. Sorry "No Storm Debris" Make sure you separate any storm debris from the garbage / yard clippings so that Republic Waste will be able to pick it up.

Storm Debris will be picked up by Harris County - It has been reported that it could be up to 180 days for all of the debris to be collected. Information is that it will be a phased collection - check with the County for more information plus we will work to keep the web site updated as information is available.

Storm Damage / Repairs

Repairs to your fence and or roofs that were caused by damage from IKE can be made without an approved ACC Form for a period of 45 days after the storm. This only includes repairs of these items and would be that the repairs were made to return the property to the original condition before the storm. This does include the color of any painting and or roof repairs. If any changes are being made to the color and or building would require an approved ACC Form before the repair could be made. This only applies for the 45 day period - if the repairs are not made within this time period an ACC Form must be submitted before the repairs are made. Garbage and Recycling Bins - Please Do Not Place Your Trash Cans In The Street

Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are to be stored out of site from the street. They should be stored in your garage and/or behind your fence. Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are not to be placed out on the curb more than 24 hours prior to our scheduled pickup of Mondays and Thursdays. Tree trimmings, limbs and branches must be cut and bundled into small bundles no longer than 4 feet, and should not weigh over 50 lbs. Heavy trash collection is on Thursday and Recycling collection is on Monday. Trash collection holidays and additional information can be found online.
